

SITE UPDATE - Q1

Works to the latest block released at Tigné Point, Q1, are now at a very advanced stage with many of the apartments approaching final completion.

Practically all of the internal mechanical, electrical and finishing fit-out works within the apartments have been completed on all floors excluding the penthouses. Finishing works have also reached a very advanced stage in the lobbies as well as the block's main entrance. External rendering works have been completed

and practically all aluminium apertures on the building are now installed and this has given the block a smart and particularly distinctive appearance, both from Pjazza Tigné and from the sea.

External paving and planting works between blocks Q1 and T10 are also in their final stages. In the underlying basement levels all mechanical and electrical systems have been installed and are currently being commissioned. Road marking and numbering works have been concluded and all access controlled entrance/exit gates, as well as fire safety doors are also in place. Private garage doors should be installed shortly.



COMING SOON - Q2

Set on the waterfront above a seduced cove, in close proximity to both the sea and a panoramic promenade that will encircle all of Tigné Point, the new Q2 residences will provide a wide selection of layouts and styles ranging from one-bed waterfront pieds-à-terre to lavish four-bed penthouses.



Construction on this new block is underway and on schedule with shell works now approaching the sixth floor. Finishes and M&E installations are set to commence later this year after a new show apartment, designed by Martin Xuereb and Associates, is finished and furnished.

Seafront living will not get much better than this.
