



## **POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS - 2021**

- Due to the Covid-19 restrictions currently in force, social distancing principles must be maintained in the pool area and sunbeds will be spaced out accordingly. Once used, all sunbeds will be removed to be disinfected and replaced with clean sunbeds. The pool deck, pool furniture and pool common areas are disinfected daily and as required. The pool changing rooms, showers and lavatories are disinfected daily and frequently on weekends and public holidays. Patrons are requested not to crowd inside the lavatories area and showers, and to always keep the required physical distance. Sanitizing points are available in the pool area. These regulations might change in accordance with the latest requirements issued by the National Standards.
- The Tigné Point Pool is open on weekdays (Monday to Friday) from 9:00am to 7:30pm and on weekends (Saturdays & Sundays) and public holidays from 9:00am to 8:00pm. Opening times will be adjusted as the days grow shorter.
- On Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday the pool will be manned for early entries as from 8:00am. The early entrance option is **ONLY** for adults and is aimed at those who wish to use the pool to conduct training laps and exercise.
- MIDI plc is allowing paid members to organise swimming lessons/training for their children, either individually or in groups of not more than four (4) children. Such lessons can **ONLY** be held between 9:00am and 10:00am from Monday to Saturday. Organisers must accept full responsibility for such lessons and must inform MIDI's pool management of their intention prior to the lessons being held.
- The pool is open **ONLY** to members in possession of a valid membership card.
- Membership cards must be shown to the pool attendant at the reception desk prior to entering the pool area. If members fail to produce their membership card, access to the pool area will not be granted.
- All membership cards are personalized and non-transferrable. Membership cards are to be used by the person named on the card only. In the case of Guest Cards, this rule does not apply.
- Holders of Guest Cards are allowed to enter the pool premises without their host member. The host remains responsible for their guests at all times.
- In order to be eligible to purchase a Guest Card a General Entry Card must first be purchased by the host member.
- Guest Cards can **ONLY** be purchased by host members.
- Guest Cards are to be validated by the pool attendant on every visit.
- A maximum of (4) guests per Guest Card are allowed into the pool at any one time per apartment and/or per host member.
- Nannies/child minders are allowed to use the parent's General Entry card if the parent does not accompany his/her children to the pool too. When child minders are accompanied by the child's parents to the pool they are considered as an additional adult and must therefore present their own membership card upon entry.
- Patrons cannot reserve sunbeds either through the pool attendant or by placing personal belongings such as towels on sunbeds. Should this occur the pool attendant is instructed to remove any items left on the sunbeds.
- Children are not allowed to run in the pool area. Children can play freely in the turfed area **ONLY** if parents are sitting in this area and no patrons are using the area.



- Young children must not be allowed alone in the lavatories and showers. Children found misbehaving will be asked to leave the pool premises.
- Children under twelve (12) years must be accompanied to the pool by an adult and supervised at all times.
- Toddlers under two (2) years old are NOT allowed in the adult pool, even if accompanied, and children under three (3) years are to wear swim-diapers.
- MIDI plc reserves the right to withdraw membership cards of un-cooperative patrons.
- Children under twelve (12) years using the wading pool (children's pool) must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- No diving or jumping is allowed in the pools.
- Toys, balls, inflatable toys, and rafts are NOT PERMITTED in the adult pool when this is being used by adults. Buoyancy aids are permitted.
- Noise levels are always to be kept to a minimum - especially between the hours of 2:00pm and 4:00pm.
- No parties are to be organised within the pool facility without the express written consent of MIDI plc.
- Headphones must be worn when listening to musical or entertainment devices.
- Patrons of the pool who have suntan lotions or body creams on are to shower before using the pool.
- Appropriate swimwear / clothing is to be worn at all times. No topless / nude bathing is permitted.
- Any member caught abusing of the facilities and / or equipment will be asked to pay for damages and their membership card will be immediately withdrawn.
- Persons who have an ear infection, a communicable condition or disease must not use the pools.
- Do not wear glasses in the pools unless necessary. Non-breakable lenses and frames are necessary for safety.
- Patrons are allowed to bring food and beverages (no glass bottles or glasses are allowed) with them to the pool. It is imperative that no food items, food containers and other litter is left behind. Following consumption any food and beverage leftovers need to be disposed of immediately in the bins provided. Food and beverages are not permitted in the pools.
- No glassware is to be taken into the pool or used in the pool deck area.
- No pets are to be brought into the pool area.
- No deckchairs, sunbeds or beach umbrellas are to be brought into the pool facilities.
- MIDI plc or its operators / managers shall not be liable for any loss or theft that may occur in the pool facilities.
- MIDI plc or its operators / managers do not accept responsibility for any injury or damage.
- Members are to follow any reasonable directions which may be given to them for reasons of health and safety, access restrictions or works in the vicinity.
- Although lifesaving equipment is in place **THE POOL IS NOT MANNED BY A LIFE-GUARD.**
